Collaborate to Saturate - Oct 16, 2024

Meeting Summary for interested friends

Eleven C2S leaders (including two support staff) reviewed our collaboration progress app released recently for beta testing. We're happy with its simplicity and functionality but decided to add 2 factor authentication for security and to limit regional leader access to their own regions. We agreed national progress snapshot entries to the app should be made in consultation with national leaders. We agreed ask our programmer for a few summary/totals fields.

We reviewed our public communication channels and received helpful suggestions. (Website: www.collaborate2saturate.org, YouTube: <https://www.youtube.com/@collaborate2saturate/videos>, Lausanne feed: <https://collaborate.lausanne.org/g/66f60fbce1022b27e7df65ca>).

We discussed our upcoming quarterly “learning community” for national leaders (Oct 29). We will need session leaders, ideally from Africa or Asia, who can be added to our learning community leadership teams in the future. Which topics should be priority for the next 2 or 3 quarters? Suggestions for leaders and topics welcome.

External facing - we reviewed a draft “one pager” (to be posted to our website by Oct 29 and introduced during our next “learning community”) overviewing ideal preparations for a national collaborative gathering, aims during the gathering and steps following. We identified several additional tools helpful to organizers of national gatherings to be posted to www.collaborate2saturate.org.

Internal facing – we reviewed a draft “one pager” outlining a share focus for our own use as simply and clearly as we can - what our team is aiming for and what we do not intend to put energy into. Helpful input to the draft was received and we intend to complete this work before the end of our in-person meetings in Honduras.

Preparations and agenda for Honduras (Feb 12-14 or 15) were reviewed. We concluded with a “round robin” in which each participant shared a suggestion or need important to our journey together and prayer.
