Internal App:

- Log-ins arrive to C2S roundtable leaders on Sept 27 for beta testing: let's explore and add info for our country or the country you are most involved in
- Feedback: if you find bugs or have suggestions, please let Murray know two weeks before Nov 5 when we train regional leaders.
- At this point, we have plans only to give access to edit app content to C2S roundtable members and to regional leaders.
- Scope of use: some who have heard of the app misunderstand it as being as widely available as other apps on Apple or Google Play. This is not so but it will be motivating to wider collaboration if national leaders can see something of progress. Therefore Murray will ask David about adding some sort of "viewing room", also requiring log-in, but showing only non-sensitive info (e.g. perhaps, a map showing general progress without any names or contact info, resources). Feedback to the idea to come.

The Collaborate to Saturate roundtable met Sept 26, 2024 over supper during Lausanne 4 in Seoul. We discussed incremental rollout of the collaboration app, security issues, and scope of use.

We reviewed “learning community” dates for regional (Nov 5) and national (Oct 29) facilitators and role & current list of regional facilitators (work in progress).

Looking ahead to our Feb 14, 2024 meeting in Honduras in conjunction with Latin American Summit, we touched on logistics and drafted agenda topics including question of how often do various categories of groups need to meet, communication channels internal and external, website content, how/why/when to fill the “empty chair,” back-office admin help, back-up plans to cover surprises in a couple areas.
