What challenge are you facing and what is your next step? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Our regional teams health range from “orange” (between red and yellow) to green. Several of us haven’t connected with our regional teams recently or adequately to know their health or issues requiring support. For some our key next step is scheduling our next 90 day conversations with our regional team leader or team.

7:30 am Managing healthy “span of care”	<p>What is a reasonable span of care to ensure every national leader is supported and no regional leader burns out? A wide range of span-of-care requires adaptive strategy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Africa-Eng,Port,Span – 30 nations Africa-Francophone - 23 nations America North – 2 nations America South & Central – 19 nations Caribbean – 28 nations Asia East – 8 nations Asia South – 8 nations (excluding India) India - 36 nations SE Asia – 11 nations Eurasia (Central Asia) – 13 nations 	<p>Step 1: discuss with our regional teams how they wish to divide or share responsibility for training and support of national teams.</p> <p>Step 2: Onboard members to our regional team or form “right-sized” sub-teams as needed to enable a healthy, sustainable span-of-care for national teams in the region.</p> <p>Step 3: Update Dulcie with names and contact info for</p>

<p>7:45 am Regional Team Training / Learning communities</p>	<p>Discussion produced the conclusion that training for regional teams cannot best be done centrally (due to language, culture and time zone differences).</p> <p>Rather onboarding and training should be done regionally by Collaboration Catalysts as required by the needs and issues of the regional context / situation.</p> <p>Our centralized contribution is to supply at least some key tools and materials for regional training through our Collaboration Catalysts.</p>	<p>Ron suggested a “training needs analysis.” Murray will explore with Ron the best way to do this, aiming to produce a process or list to be reviewed during our next CC conversation.</p> <p>As we progress, CCs will arrange training for their regional teams as needed, inviting others to visit for specific training topics.</p>
